Afrezza (oral inhalation insulin)	Refrigerate (if not refrigerated use within 10 days)
Apidra (insulin glulisine) PEN & VIAL	28 days
Basaglar (insulin glargine) PEN	28 days
Fiasp (insulin aspart) PEN & VIAL	28 days
Humalog (insulin lispro) PEN & VIAL	28 days
Humalog Mix 50/50	Pens – 10 days Vials – 28 days
Humalog Mix 75/25 (insulin lispro protamine + insulin lispro)	Pens – 10 days Vials – 28 days
Humulin N (insulin NPH)	Pens – 14 days Vials – 31 days
Humulin N (insulin NPH) VIAL	31 days
Humulin R & U-500 (insulin regular) VIAL	31 days
Humulin 70/30 (NPH / regular)	Pens – 10 days Vials – 31 days
Lantus (insulin glargine) PEN & VIAL	28 days
Levemir (insulin detemir) PEN & VIAL	42 days
Novolin 70/30 (NPH / regular) VIAL	42 days
Novolin N VIAL	28 days
Novolin R VIAL	42 days
Novolog (insulin aspart) PEN & VIAL	28 days
Novolog Mix 70/30	Pens – 14 days Vials – 28 days
Ryzodeg 70/30 (insulin aspart + degludec)	28 days
Toujeo (insulin glargine) PEN	42 days
Tresiba (insulin degludec)	56 days
Insulin and GLP-1 Inhibitor Combo	
Soliqua (lixisenatide + long acting insulin)	28 days
Xultophy (liraglutide + long-acting insulin)	21 days
GLP-1 Inhibitors	
Adlyxin (lixisenatide)	14 days
Bydureon (exenatide)	28 days
Bydureon ER/BCise (exenatide)	28 days
Byetta (exenatide)	30 days

Ozempic (semaglutide)	56 days
Saxenda (liraglutide) <small>indicated for weight loss</small>	30 days
Tanzeum (albiglutide)	Unused pens stored for \leq 4 weeks prior to reconstitution at room temp. Use within 8 hours of reconstitution.
Trulicity (dulaglutide)	14 days
Victoza (liraglutide)	30 days

*All medications above should be kept in the refrigerator until used. The expiration dates on this chart start when the medication is removed from the fridge and used for the first time.
